

## **INDIAN REGIONAL LANGUAGES**

The Parliament Library has been laying great emphasis on developing its language collections. A separate wing containing nearly 37,638 books (as on 31 December 2016) in various Indian Regional languages has been carved out in the Library in the Basement-I. The languages covered, apart from Hindi and Sanskrit, are, Assamese; Bengali; Bodo; Dogri; Gujarati; Kannada; Kashmiri; Konkani; Malayalam; Manipuri; Marathi; Maithili; Nepali; Oriya; Punjabi; Rajasthani; Sindhi; Tamil; Telugu; and Urdu. Concerted efforts are under way to enrich this collection by adding more and more basic standard works in each of these and also other Indian Regional languages.

In addition to these the Parliament Library is also receiving 32 periodicals in various Regional languages. All these language periodicals are displayed in the Library Hall, Parliament House. The latest newspapers in regional languages are also displayed in the Library Hall, Parliament House for the information and use of members.
